

3TS GOLF TOURNAMENT

RULES & CONDITIONS



- Entry is open to all members of GI registered golf clubs in Ireland.
- The national finals will be played under the R&A Rules of Golf.

Teams:

- Team consists of Club Lady Captain and Men's Captain, together with winners of both a men's and a ladies' club competition.
- 3Ts Club Competition can be run in conjunction with an existing club competition, as the clubs shall decide.
- Winning team names, World Golf Handicaps and GI Numbers must be submitted by 28th August, together with entry fees and completed entry form.
- It is condition of entry that the dates of play of the club competitions and the number of competitors in both the men's and ladies' club competitions are submitted to the 3Ts on the entry form accompanied by entry fee.
- All team members must have participated in the club competition and paid the entry fee of €10.
- Entrants must be 18 years of age or over.
- Entry fees cannot be put towards club prizes. All entry fees must be sent to 3Ts.

Handicaps: World Golf Handicaps as applied by Golf Ireland to apply.

Scoring:

- The 3Ts Golf Tournament is an 18-hole stableford event for teams.
- Best two net scores at each hole count unless otherwise stated.
- In the event of a tie for leading position, there will be a card play-off decider as follows:
 - Lowest net score on holes 10-18 and if still a tie
 - Lowest net score on holes 13-18 and if still a tie
 - Lowest net score on holes 16-18 and if still a tie
 - Lowest net score on 18th hole and if still a tie
 - Sudden death card play-off starting at Hole no. 1.

Prizes: Players in the leading two teams at the Final venues will receive prizes.
